



## What is Ultra?

The construction of Ultra provides superior stability while giving you the same sanding life as a solid wood floor. This product is an engineered flooring type, meaning it is made up of several layers, each with its own purpose. This type of flooring is perfectly suited for New Zealand's climate conditions and will not experience the same stabilty issues that are associated with solid wood flooring.

**Ultra also saves the hassle of finishing onsite.** It comes already finished and is ready to use as soon as installation is complete - making your life easy!



# Benefits:

### √ Strength and stability

Ultra has a 6mm wear layer, equal to the wear layer on most solid timber floors and therefore has the same sanding life. Wear layers are made from a selection of the world's best hardwoods, specially chosen for their strength and stability. The cross-directional base layers of this floor type are very strong and rigid, making Ultra much more resistant to shrinkage and cupping than traditional solid wood flooring.

#### ✓ European style

The Ultra range is developed around European flooring trends and is constantly evolving with new and unique colours, finishes and textures as the fashions change. Colours are unique and created specially for the New Zealand market so with Ultra you can be sure you are always in style.

#### √ Time saving

Ultra is supplied already finished with hardwearing lacquer or UV cured oil. This flooring requires no further finishing after installation, saving you the noise, dust, smells and wait times associated with a floor finished on site. A great time saver for those who want to get the job done!

#### √ Easy Installation

Ultra comes boxed and ready to install. This floor type can be either direct stuck, laid straight on joists, or floated. Ultra requires no further finishing after installation is complete.

## √ Under-floor heating compatible


The cross-directional base layers of the Ultra board greatly increase its resistance to problems caused by humidity and heat, meaning Ultra is compatible for use with most underfloor heating systems.

## √ Environmentally conscious

The construction of Ultra uses about one third of the amount of solid hardwood resource in comparison to traditional solid wood flooring of the same dimensions. We are careful to only use sustainably managed hardwoods and have PEFC certification for species where supply is a concern. The ply base layers are also PEFC certified.

All Ultra products are supplied with a 25 year structural warranty.




