Otsumigaki

JAPANESE CLAY LIME

Formulated in the tradition of lime and clay-based Japanese plasters, Otsumigaki creates a soothing, stonelook finish with modern textural depth.

The beauty of ROCKCOTE Otsumigaki lies in its ability to create textural depth in a smooth, flat surface.

Meaning 'polished and compressed' in Japanese, Otsumigaki is applied with a trowel in two tight coats and then polished with a Japanese trowel and Carnauba wax. The polishing process compresses the lime and clay creating a soft, smooth, even feel across the surface and a pearly lustre finish.

In contrast with the often dramatic and highly polished appearance of European inspired plasters (such as Venetian plaster), Otsumigaki offers a dreamier, slightly stony look with a more subtle colour range in its patina.

ROCKCOTE Otsumigaki can be used in high traffic interior areas in residential settings such as entrances, stairwells and halls.









A beautiful alternative to painted walls, Otsumigaki delivers a smooth, evocative aesthetic with a subtle lustre.
