To add real value to your home and day-to-day life, we recommend you ask yourself these six important questions when exploring options for an outdoor shelter.





We invented indoor outdoor flow.

The first tip is to consider how you're going to use the new outdoor space. For example, do you want a year-round outdoor living space? Or would you rather create an area for the more temperate months of the year?

The other key consideration is whether you'll need to block prevailing winds or sun ingress into a specific room. Make sure you share this information with your local Archgola™ expert, to ensure you get a canopy that's a perfect fit for your intended purpose.

Feel the sun, not the burn.

Your choice of roofing type and colour is a critical consideration.

We have roof options that offer different combinations of heat and light penetration. If a cooler shade is top of your list, consider the Laserlite Frost, or perhaps you don't mind the warmth, and want to see the stars,

then the Linear Bronze could be the go. Take a look at all the roofing samples, and if you're not sure, ask if you can be shown examples of canopies in your area with different roof types and colours to help you make your final decision.

TIP TWO





It's not the size of your deck that matters.

Measure the dimensions of your outdoor space and take note of its shape. This information will be crucial when planning the layout and choosing the best furniture and features. If you've got a large deck you may want to consider covering only half the area and allowing the remainder to be exposed.

Regulations require canopies over 30 sqm to have council consent. Archgola™ can arrange this for you, but it does involve additional plans and drawings, which adds to the cost, so it may be something you consider when thinking about the size.

Stands out. Fits in.

What powder coat colour do you want for the frame? Many people match their existing joinery to the canopy frame. In doing this, the canopy becomes an extension of the house and it all looks cohesive. Alternatively, a contrast can be effective.

Archgola powder coating offers superior durability and corrosion protection, exceptional resistance to chipping, scratching and wear and ensures the frame is highly resistant to moisture/ corrosion creep if damaged.

TIP FOUR





Rain, wind or shine.

Do you want to use the outdoor living area year-round? If the answer's yes, you might like to consider adding outdoor blinds. They're a great way to enclose a space and they'll ensure you can enjoy the area year-round by blocking prevailing winds and rain.

They also make it so much easier to heat the area on those really cold winter days. Whilst outdoor blinds can be added to your canopy at any time, it's vital to inform your local Archgola™ expert that you may want outdoor blinds at some point. This is so that allowances can be made when the canopy is being designed.

Four seasons in one hour.

We take care of water flow. Most canopies will require a downpipe and guttering. In rare circumstances some small canopies over terraces and the like may not require them.

From an aesthetic point of view, consider the location of the downpipe.

If you've got a great view to enjoy from the shelter of your new canopy, the last thing you'll want is a down pipe intruding on it. Work with your local Archgola™ expert to determine the location for the downpipe that's as unobtrusive as possible.
