

# Protecting, Cleaning & Maintaining Your Oiled Wood Floor

## Protect



Place felt pads under chairs and table feet. Never place pot plants directly onto a wooden floor. Always use a pot stand.

## Clean



Remove dirt with a vacuum cleaner (brush only) or broom. Grains of sand/dirt may scratch the surface. A newly oiled floor should be vacuumed/broomed/dry mopped only for first 10 days.

## Spot Clean



Use Osmo Wash and Care Cleaner for spot cleaning as required. For black rubber or shoe marks rub with a dry cloth.

## Mop



REGULARLY mop your floor with Osmo Wash and Care Cleaner and a micro fibre spray mop. Never use excessive amounts of water. Allow the floor to completely dry before walking on it.

Never use a Steam Mop!

## Maintain



In time (2-3 years, depending on foot traffic, etc) your floor may require a coat of Maintenance Oil to keep it in its optimum condition. First clean the floor as above (vacuum, spot clean and mop the floor and allow to dry completely).

Apply Maintenance Oil sparingly to the floor by either a spray bottle or a cloth.

For smaller areas rub the oil in the direction of the grain with a cloth to buff in, and remove the excess.

For larger areas a buffing machine from a hire centre can be used.

Drying time:

Approximately 6-12 hours.

*Do not use Maintenance Oil in the first year, or on a floor that has not been washed regularly.*



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
