



Construction of a new, large-format, temperature-controlled distribution centre.

Bidfood's Auckland North Distribution Centre expanded the company's capacity to deliver timely orders, especially to those customers north of the Waitematā Harbour. Up to 12 trucks at a time can be serviced at environmental load areas, and the centre provides a large dry store as well as temperature-controlled storage for more than 4300 pallets of product.

A significant cut and removal of existing materials was required across the entire site, so we focused on achieving a precise and efficient construction programme in consultation with the project's architect and engineers. Due to comprehensive planning, site activities worked in well with each other. Haul roads used for taking earthworks spoil off the site did not isolate any live construction areas.

The construction project includes a 1540m² coldstore, a 440m² chiller, a 1600m² dry store and more than 900m² of environmental load areas (ELAs). Special-purpose facilities include a plant room, forklift recharge room and a large drive-through canopy. We constructed four-metre-high timber retaining walls to stabilise areas along the boundary where deep excavations were necessary. The project has a clear safety and environmental record.

Moana New Zealand (formerly Aotearoa Fisheries) is the largest Māori-owned seafood company and the second largest seafood company in terms of quota volume and value in New Zealand. It fishes and harvests solely from Aotearoa New Zealand coastal waters.

Moana Seafood wanted to have more of a focus on the live lobster market so engaged Q Construction to convert an existing warehouse into a state of the art, purpose built live lobster facility including holding tanks and filtration systems.

New Zealand's lobster is the champagne of lobster in the Asian market, highly regarded for its light, sweet and rich taste with a firm flesh.

A wide range of grades is available, from A (up to 600g) through to F (2.5kg+). Their factories are governed by strict food safety programmes to ensure quality standards that start with the harvester and are carried right through to the market.

Q successfully managed construction of the new facility to ensure no disruption to daily activities of the existing surrounding operations. Our previous experience with coldstores facilities, specialist finishes and related services proved beneficial when managing sub trades.

This new build multi-development includes three separate buildings – a 2,500m² head office, a seafood importer and a distributor cold store. The building includes 1,500m² of cold store, 500m² office and 500m² of loading area. To the front of the development site, there are another two warehouse/office buildings, each comprising 1,500m² of office and warehouse.

It was challenging for the owner to obtain building consent, but Q Commercial Construction worked tirelessly with the client and his consultant team as the project evolved with a fantastic result.

A design and build project for Ottogi NZ Ltd comprising warehousing with incorporated two-level office area. The warehousing consisted of dry store storage facility, two temperature controlled chillers and an environmental load out facility including all associated specialist docks, levelers and rapid doors.

During extensive consultation with Ottogi, Q were able to complete a design that best suited our clients needs utilising the site adjacent to their existing facility. The site posed some challenges with respect to existing geotechnical conditions all of which were incorporated into the design - bulk fill to form a raised building platform and driven timber piles. Post tensioned floor slabs provided the seamless floor that our client required for longevity and low maintenance.

Working closely with local utility companies we were able to find the best outcome for the client with respect to several existing services encroaching into the property boundaries. The build was completed both on time and on budget.

Some strategic thinking was needed to keep this food manufacturer's project on target. We constructed an extension to the fully cooked line at Leader Products Otahuhu site.

This project entailed building a food-hygiene environment adjoining an existing plant while the rest of the processing factory kept operating normally, manufacturing frozen convenience foods for retail, food service, industrial and quick service restaurant clients.

In the early stages of the construction project, changes needed to be made to the already-approved design with multiple applications to Auckland Council to amend the building consent.

Motivated to keep the construction project progressing while the consents were partially reviewed, we spoke to the project's consultants and key tradespeople and made significant changes to the project programme and sequencing of works.

This proactive approach minimised delays during the construction phase and enabled the project to meet critical installation dates for equipment at the new facility.


